

Supporting Accurate Views of Emergency Services Act of 2021 or the 911 SAVES Act

This bill requires the Office of Management and Budget, by 30 days after the bill's enactment, to categorize public safety telecommunicators as a protective service occupation under the Standard Occupational Classification System.

- **US Senate (S 1175)** - Read on 4/15/21, Introduced in Senate, read twice, referred to Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
 - Sponsor, Sen Richard Burr [R-NC], 10 Co-Sponsors (5 Republican/5 Democratic) = 7 out of 100
 - Recent activity: April -1 (Klobuchar), May -1, June - 3, July-1, Sept-1, Dec-1, Feb-1, Mar-1
 - Sen Klobuchar original co-sponsor (4/15/21), Sen Tina Smith (TBD-signed last congress)
